



Wildfire Mitigation Checklist

There are many simple steps you can take to reduce the potential damage a fire could cause to your home and property.

- Learn about the wildfire risk in your area and your community's plan for responding to a wildfire.
- Maintain the plants around your house throughout the year and cultivate the defensible space around your property.
- Keep combustible materials away from your house.
- Ensure your roof and house siding are made of non-flammable material.
- Use wire mesh to cover vents into your house that embers could get into.
- Check with your insurer annually to make sure they have an up-to-date picture of your property and you know what your home policy covers. Keep an inventory of important items in your home, garage, and property area.
